**Salon** An Italian mid-century sofa from Geoffrey Hatty Applied Arts adds a pop of colour here, having been reupholstered in a 'Butternut' velvet from Pollack's 'Solo' range. A vintage Arne Jacobsen 'Swan' chair (available from Fritz Hansen) continues the modernist theme, complemented by two 'Semi' pendant lights by Claus Bonderup and Torsten Thorup for Gubi. On the floor is a piece from Loom Rugs' 'Kundan' collection, and the 'Bell' coffee table is by Sebastian Herkner for ClassiCon. Carlo Golin's *Loganberries* from Fletcher Arts hangs on one wall, on the opposite is a series of prints belonging to the homeowner, which hang above a vintage side table. Vico Magistretti's 'Atollo 239' table lamp by Oluce sits next to two vases in brass and resin from Dinosaur Designs ➤
